At the December 10, 2008 Regular Meeting Village Council:

- Reviewed the minutes of the Nov. 12th Regular Meeting.
- Reviewed and approved the Nov., 2008 financial reports, including payments.
- Heard the third reading and adoption of Resolution 12-08 adopting the Public Defender contract .
- Heard the second reading of resolution 13-08 amending the certificate for the fire fund.
- Heard the first reading of Resolution 14-08 adopting the temporary appropriations for 2009.
- Heard the first reading of Resolution G-08 approving, adopting and enacting the Basic Code, 2009 Edition as code of ordinances.
- Heard the first reading of Resolution 15-08 requesting a Certificate of Estimated Tax Revenue from the County Auditor to place a 6.9 mil Operating Levy on 11/2009 ballot.
- Heard the first reading of Resolution 16-08 adopting the public Defender's Contract extension.
- Heard the first reading of Resolution 18-08 contracting with Wolfe, Wilson, and Phillips for the 2007-2008 audit.

• All Disaster Plan

The preliminary flood plain maps have been received and it reduced the overall flood plain for Amesville.

• Mayor's Report

Mayor Hare suggests getting DSL for the office to deal with increasing demands for online reporting and communication.

- **Water and Wastewater Committee:** Policy adopted to have Mayor Frank Hare authorize refunds on excess of \$.70 per 100 gallons in those months when customers hook up to the wastewater system. No exemptions to wastewater charges for the following items: leaks, pools, lawn and garden watering, washing of vehicles, etc.
